Description: Make this cute basket with pockets that are embellished with appliqué flowers.

Techniques Explored: Blanket stitch appliqué

Supply List

Sewing machine

Presser Feet: #37 (1/4" patchwork), #20 (appliqué foot), #10 (edgestitch foot) and walking foot

Pattern: Suzi Purse Insert and More

Fabrics: per pattern (note~our outside pockets are pink with dots and our cover/lining and inside pockets are a pink print)

Interfacing: per patten (note~Décor Bond works well)

Scraps of fabrics (we used a solid charm pack) backed with Heat N Bond Lite for the appliqués. The largest flower measures 3" wide. You can make as many or as few appliqués as you want. We will be cutting your appliqués using the Go! System so be generous with your scraps and allow for a mistake or two. :)

Mettler thread—to match fabrics

Isacord or other decorative thread for the blanket stitch appliqué (note~using a matching threads hides mistakes)

Basic quilting supplies (rotary cutter, ruler, mat)

Fabric marking chalk or pencil
