Description: This cute basket has vinyl pockets that are edged with a double fold bias tape.

Techniques Explored: Sewing with vinyl and using a bias binder (less expensive) or binding attachment (more expensive)

Supply List

Sewing machine

Presser Feet: #52 (non-slip foot), #8 (jeans foot), #10 (edgestitch foot) and #85 (bias binder) OR #88 (binding attachment)

Pattern: Suzi Purse Insert and More

Fabrics: per pattern (note~ We made the small insert for this pocket and it only required one fat quarter of fabric.)

Interfacing: per patten (note~D cor Bond works well)

If using the Bias binder you will need to bring one package of narrow double fold bias tape

If using the Binding attachment you will need about 3 yards of precut bias that is starched and cut the size that is needed for your attachment.

Mettler thread—to match fabrics

Basic quilting supplies (rotary cutter, ruler, mat)

Fabric marking chalk or pencil

We will provide the 12 gauge vinyl for you to make one basket.

Bring a lunch to class as you will be here until the early afternoon.
