**Description:** Since nobody likes to sew their garments from scratch any longer, it is necessary for us to do embroidery with the garments already made. **Techniques Explored:** Using the new free-arm adapter for the BERNINA embroidery machines.

## **Supply List**

Sewing machine with embroidery module  
Presser feet: #26 (embroidery foot),

One knit t-shirt or sweatshirt (I bought a v-neck shirt from Lands End)  
Poly-Mesh stabilizer for the oval hoop

Large oval hoop  
Free-arm adapter for the BERNINA embroidery machine  
Isacord thread: 0870, 5933, 2241, 0851, 2224, 2152, 0832  
4" square pieces of fabric for the appliqué. Red that should match with #2224 and green that should match with 5933

Basic embroidery supplies

You will need one embroidery designs for class that I will email and you need to save to a USB stick or your machine.
