Description

Make a bowl, basket or even purse out of clothesline and fabric strips. It is a very easy technique that once you learn you won't be able to stop. All of the Bernina machines can easily handle this project.

Techniques Explored: Wrapped thread and zip sagging coils together. The trick is to learn how to shape your object.

Supply List

Sewing machine
Presser Feet: #1 or #59
Clothesline
Mettler thread: to match
Pieces of fabric. These can be: jelly rolls, Bali Pops, fat quarters, yardage, or long strips cut on the cross grain.
Basic quilting supplies

What to do before class

If you are using Jelly Rolls or Bali Pops, you do not need to do anything. If you are bring fat quarters or yardage, you need to bring your rotary cutter, mat and ruler. You will be cutting your strips into 3/4" wide strips.

This is a very fun project.
