

Christmas Club—Ornament Pot Pincher

Description: In this month's club we will be making a very simple pot pincher. The fun part about this pot pincher is that it looks like a Christmas ornament. The front of the pot pincher has decorative stitches that were done using the embroidery machine. There is even a ribbon that is appliquéd to add a little more interest. This gift is easy and practical. You might want to make them in different colors to suit the recipient's décor.

Techniques Explored: Embroidery that incorporates ribbons, using Pattern runs.

Supply List

Sewing machine with embroidery

Presser feet: #26 (tear-drop embroidery foot), Walking foot, #8 (jeans foot) or #1 (zig zag foot)

The following fabrics:

1 ~ 9" x 14" fabric AND cotton batting to be hooped

3 ~ 7" squares of fabric

2 ~ 7" square of cotton batting

Assortment of coordinating threads. (I used two reds, one gold and one green)

18" of ribbon for embroidery (We used the green)

6" of ribbon for the hanger

Basic embroidery supplies

There is no reason to bring your mat and cutter if you have your fabrics cut out before the beginning of class.

The design to have loaded onto your PDS or machine is:
Ornament pot pincher oval hoop.art

These is also a design made especially for the jumbo hoop if anyone is interested.
