Description

This boxy jacket will be your go-to item when you are wearing any type of casual slacks. It could take you grocery shopping or to a casual dinner. The jacket uses 8 different fabrics that are pieced and quilted to make the outside. One fabric is used to make the lining. The finishing touch is a binding all around the outside and on the edges of the sleeves. One additional detail is the 1/4" flanges that separate the strips of fabric. Use all of your favorite quilting cottons to make this fun item.

Techniques Explored: piecing, quilting, binding, basic garment construction techniques, fitting

Presser Feet: #37 (1/4") or #57 (1/4" with guide), walking foot

Park Avenue Jacket pattern

Fabrics as per pattern

Mettler thread: to match

Basic quilting and sewing supplies



Schedule

5/27—Cut out fabrics

6/3—Sew strips together

6/10—Fit jacket

6/17—Piece jacket

6/24—Assemble jacket

7/1—Bind
