**Description:** We had so much fun last month making the Polarfleece Shawl that I thought it would be fun to get the serger out again and make these Polarfleece slippers. Many years ago for Christmas I made Polarfleece slippers for everyone in my family. They were a huge hit. I will give you the pattern to make these slippers in three different sizes. The bottom picture shows my size 10 “boats” in the size medium. The slippers are very comfortable and warm. I can’t wait to wear them while I watch TV by the fireplace.

**Techniques Explored:** Using the serger.

## **Supply List**

Serger with 4 matching threads

Fabric: 1/2 yard of Polarfleece and 1/4 yard of coordinating ribbing.  
If you cut them carefully you should be able to make two pairs from this amount of fabric.

Paper scissors and fabric scissors

Pattern ease\*

Basic sewing supplies

\*I will provide you with one copy of the pattern. You might want to trace the pattern so that you can use all of the sizes.
